## CLINICAL SERVICES AIDE FOR ADULT SERVICES

This is a paraprofessional high school graduate level position designed to assist persons who meet medical necessity criteria for community living supports and skill building services. The position incumbent will provide a wide range of direct assistance to consumers (within the scope of his/her training) and within the framework of the consumers Individual Plan of Service (IPOS). The services provided are designed to increase or maintain personal self-sufficiency and support recovery.

### Job Description:

- Supporting the consumer during the person-centered planning process and promoting choice.
- Assistance with the acquisition, retention or improvement of self-help, socialization, and adaptive skills.
- Hands on interventions outlined in the IPOS recommended by the Therapist, OT, PT, speech therapies or Evidence Based Practice.
- Assistance with access to entitlement, and /or legal representation.
- Coordination and attendance at appointments with primary care physician, dentist or other medical provider.
- Responsible for skills building, monitoring, support services, and transportation.

### Job Qualifications:

- High School Diploma or GED
- At least 18 years of age
- Must be certified in First Aid and CPR
- Communicate expressively and receptively
- Possess a valid driver's license and personal transportation
- Function under the guidance and leadership of a QIDP, QMHP, or CMHP
